Submission done by college during hearing is not accepted because practicals must be done in the dissection hall of the college. The committee asked regarding functionality of dissection hall, college accepted that college has dissection hall but they are not doing dissection in the dissection hall because it is constructed over the temple of Mataji. It proves dissection hall of the college is non-functioning.

All the batches have got advantage of learning through dissection.</p> <p>However, we do agree that last cadaver was procured earlier, but since then we are in communication with all sources to procure the cadaver. On the keen observation it was found that it was technical error of biometric machine in regard to data export system to either pdf or excel. Immediately machine was sent for correction to external technical experts and the error was corrected. The bill and bill payment record and biometric record of 23.02.2025 is attached herewith as annexure-6.	Submission regarding reason of technical error in biometric device is not acceptable. ***Considering the observations of Hearing Committee with regards to following points.**

1. Dissection hall available in Separate building, Last cadaver Procurement documents are of 22/07/2022 and does not seem to be satisfactory.
2. CCTV footage of biometric is not provided for the given three consecutive dates(either 16th, 17th & 18th of January 2025 or 8th, 9th & 10th of January 2025).
3. As per the biometric attendance submitted by the institute for the given three dates, the data seems to be doubtful because-
There are multiple biometrics at same time (hour: minute: second) in given 3 days biometric data provided by institute. There are few entries with AM and PM notations, whereas maximum are without this. Even font case for notation varies at places. 20:15:00 timing is denoted with AM notation, which is suspicious. At some places the time is mentioned in three digits like 240,160 etc.: Biometric attendance found to be fabricated by the hearing committee.

The Academic Council is in unanimous opinion that the Institute shall be affiliated for Academic year 2025-26 with 10% Seat Reduction.
